Es wird empfohlen, handelsübliche Reinigungs- und Pflegemittel für die jeweilige Materialart zu verwenden, die sich nicht negativ auf den Benutzer auswirken. Es wird nicht empfohlen, zusätzliche Desinfektionsmethoden und Desinfektionsmittel zu verwenden, da sich dies auf die Verminderung des Schutzniveaus auswirken kann.

Die bestimmte maximale Anzahl von Reinigungszyklen ist nicht der einzige Faktor mit Auswirkung auf die Haltbarkeit der Kleidung. Die Haltbarkeitsdauer hängt auch von der Art und Weise des Gebrauchs, Aufbewahrung usw. ab.

Aufbewahrung: Das Produkt sollte bei der entsprechenden Temperatur gelagert werden, an einem trockenen, gut belüfteten Ort. Eine hohe Feuchtigkeit, zu hohe oder niedrige Temperatur oder intensives Licht können die Qualität des Produkts beeinträchtigen. Der Hersteller haftet nicht für die Qualität des Produkts, das nicht entsprechend den Empfehlungen aufbewahrt wird. Dies kann den Grad des Produkts reduzieren.

Art der Verpackung: Es wird empfohlen, dieses Produkt in Verpackungen aus Pappe oder Folie zu vertreiben (einschließlich des Transports). Die Beladung, Transport und Entladung sollten unter Bedingungen stattfinden, die gegen Durchnässung, Verschmutzung und Beschädigung geschützt sind.

Die **Haltbarkeitsdauer** kann aufgrund des Niveaus der Abnutzung des Produkts eingeschätzt werden. Aufgrund der unterschiedlichen Beanspruchung und der Umweltfaktoren wie Sonnenlicht, Regen usw. ist die Angabe einer genauen Lebensdauer des Produktes nicht möglich. EN INSTRUCTION AND INFORMATION FOR THE USERS

Manufacturer RAW-POL STEFANSKI SPÓŁKA KOMANDYTOWO-AKCYJNA, Julianów 50, 96-200 Julianów, Poland.

This product belongs to the Personal Protective Equipment (PPE), defined in the Regulation (EU) 2016/425 of the European Parliament and of the Council and meets the guidelines of that regulation. It has been assigned to the I category.

Standards: EN ISO 20471:2013+A1:2016 „High visibility clothing. Test methods and requirements“; EN 343:2003+A1:2007 „Protective clothing. Protection against rain“; EN 14058:2017 „Protective clothing. Garments for protection against cool environments“; EN ISO 13688:2013+A1:2021 „Protective clothing. General requirements“.

The notified body: SGS Fimko Oy, Takomatie 8, FI-00380 Helsinki, Finland, number of the body: 0598.

Product description: Protective high visibility clothing. Detailed characterisation of the product is provided in rawpol.com.

Purpose: The clothing of high visibility is intended to assure increased visibility of the user in any light, when he/she is in the field vision of vehicle operators or other mechanized equipment in the daytime and in the dark under the lights of the vehicles. Clothing also protects against minimal risks such as: superficial mechanical injury that do not need medical attention, e.g. scratches resulting from bumping into fixed obstacles and gardening; atmospheric conditions that are not of an extreme nature, i.e. atmospheric precipitation (eg rain, snow, fog and high humidity and cool temperature higher than -5 °C. Working time depends on many factors, such as wind power or individual user's characteristics or work environment, therefore all these factors should be taken into account when assessing a given work environment. More information about the conditions in which the tests were conducted can be obtained at rawpol.com or directly from a manufacturer, an authorized representative or an authorized distributor. The garment is intended to protect against water penetration. The level of protection was obtained on the basis of tests carried out according to conditions described in the norms / specifications to which they apply. The product provides protection against high visibility clothing. Detailed characterisation of the product is provided in rawpol.com.

Use and operation: The personal liability of the user is determined to ensure protective function of the product. This product is intended to be worn. This product must be put on the body. If the product has any fasteners, they need to be fastened/ zipped. If the product has components to tie, they need to be tied. It should be noted that the product lies comfortably and gives freedom of movement to do this, match all kinds of adjustments, if any. In order to remove the product, first unfasten/unzip all previously fastened/zipped elements and untie previously tied elements, if any. In order to assure optimal protection of the product, it must be worn always buttoned up, kept clean and do not restrict visibility of the product through covering. Visibility of the product can be reduced in the case of improper cleaning or modification of the product. The product permanently discoloured or permanently soiled must be replaced. While wearing, the reflective belts must be on the outside. If the product is worn together with other means of personal protection, total protection features must be guaranteed depending on the purpose. In any case the requirements take precedence. Before using, the user checks on his/her own responsibility, whether the product is suitable for working activities, is complete, clean, not faded, and whether all functions are guaranteed. Check the damages, whether they could have a negative impact on the safety functions (e.g. cracks, holes, ripped seams, broken prongs, worn reflective belts). If there is such a negative impact, before using, restore the original valid status of the product (to do this, contact the manufacturer or the authorised representative of the manufacturer), and if this is not possible, replace it. While working, pay attention to keep the protective functions. Loss of the protective functions means that the product has been worn. Do not use a damaged or worn out product. The product does not have additional equipment and spare parts.

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
